



Head Coach for all Icelandic National Teams in Bowling

The Icelandic Bowling Association (IBA) is offering the position of Head Coach for National Teams. The Head Coach works according to the Achievement Strategy of the Association and reports to the National Team Committee, General Manager, and The Board. Head Coach oversees the selection of high-achieving groups of children & youth, women, men, and seniors in consultation with The National Team Committee and clubs within the Association. Head Coach is also in charge of selecting assistant coaches, it is required that assistant coaches will be selected within the group of Icelandic coaches. Head Coach is responsible for talent development of young people as well as overseeing training and preparation of competition teams for tournaments in cooperation with assistant coaches. The Head Coach is responsible for informing the National Team Committee, General Manager and Board regularly about development and performance of the groups, as well as following the Associations Code of Conduct and Achievement strategy in his work.

Main tasks and responsibilities

- Enforce Achievement Strategy and support development of the Association's achievement goals
- Manage selection of high-achieving groups of children & youth, women, men, and seniors
- Manage talent development of young people in consultation with the General Manager
- Choose assistant coach for the projects in consultation with The National Team Committee
- Select the appropriate competition groups for each tournament
- Training and preparation of teams in cooperation with assistant coaches and the clubs
- Reporting and informing towards General Manager, The National Team Committee and Board

Education and qualification requirements

- A minimum of EBF Level II or similar validated by EBF
- Active coaching experience in bowling for the past two years at least
- Experience with National Team training an advantage
- Experience in training of all age and gender groups is an advantage
- A clean record towards chapter XXII of the Icelandic general criminal law (sexual assault chapter)
- Desire to develop and promote the sport of bowling in Iceland.

The job involves that Head Coach will be coming to Iceland at least 2 times every year to evaluate high-achieving competitors in a National Tournament and follow up with training camps.
